Responsibilities

- Conduct, in partnership with the President, regular Executive Committee meetings and meetings of the general membership at least monthly during the academic year or as deemed necessary
- Attend General USPA Meetings
- Attend ACCP executive board meetings
- Coordinate organizational clinical and outreach events

Treasurer

Responsibilities

- Responsible for establishing and maintaining all financial records for the chapter.
- Works closely with the executive board to ensure that the chapter has the funds necessary to accomplish its goals
- Keeps a written account of all chapter financial transactions
- Assists in establishing a budget for each organizational event and an annual budget for the chapter, including allocations for events, national programs and annual conference, and ensures that it is followed
- Applies for various funds
- Reports regularly to the board and members about the chapter's financial status
- Submits a budget proposal to ASUU and USPA at the beginning of each semester as required
- **Required** to attend and present the organization's budget request to ASUU at Capitol Hill

Project/Event Coordinator

Responsibilities

- Oversees the operations of projects and events
- Coordinates presentation schedules with members and relays information to the President and President-Elect
- Coordinates events
 - At least 1 each semester
- Coordinates shadowing events
 - Fall and Spring semesters
- Responsible for one fundraising event to be completed by the end of the year
 - May seek help/insight from fellow members (treasurer)
- Helps create co-curricular signups for events

The President-Elect/Program Chairperson shall perform such duties as the President shall from time to time delegate to him/her and shall perform such other duties as the Student Chapter Officers shall designate. In the temporary absence or disability of the President, the President-Elect shall perform all the duties of the President, and when so acting shall have all the powers of, and be subject to all the restrictions on, the President. The President-Elect shall assume the position of President upon the conclusion of the term of the sitting President. The President-Elect shall also be responsible for the coordination, planning, marketing and execution of all Student Chapter meetings and programs.

The Secretary/Membership Chairperson shall attend all meetings of the members and the Student Chapter Officers. 

 - Be in **good academic standing**
 - GPA of at least 3.00 cumulative AND each semester
 - No individual grades below C+
 - Not on academic probation or in violation of the COP's Academic Integrity Policy


