Nonstop Flights to Phoenix, AZ and Las Vegas, NV: Nonstop daily direct flights from Gallup, NM to Phoenix International Airport (1 hour flight). You can also fly direct (non-stop) from Gallup, NM, to Las Vegas, NV (1 hour and 15-minute flight). Once you arrive in Phoenix (Phoenix International Airport) or Las Vegas (Harry Reid International Airport), you can then easily take a direct flight (non-stop) to the majority of cities in the USA and some international cities.

Driving distance from Gallup, NM, to Phoenix, AZ, is 4 hours and 30 minutes. Gallup, NM to Albuquerque, NM: 1 hour and 45 minutes.

Train Service: Gallup, NM, is one of the stops on Amtrak's Train Service. You can take the train from Gallup, NM, to Los Angeles, CA, Flagstaff, AZ, Albuquerque, NM, Kansas City, Mo, and Chicago, IL.

- **Gallup, NM-** is in the incredible and stunning Mountain West.
